**MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF  
THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT  
HELD ON JANUARY 10, 2017**

- CALL TO ORDER** A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District was held on Tuesday, January 10, 2017, at 8366 Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.
- ROLL CALL** President Taylor; Directors Cammarano, Chan, Cici, and DeLaTorre; General Manager Prior; Assistant General Manager Feilen; Finance and Administration Manager Corona; and District Counsel Colin O'Neill were present.
- AGENDA** Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre, and seconded by Director Cici, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the agenda for this regular meeting of the Board of Directors held on January 10, 2017.
- MINUTES** Upon motion by Director Chan and seconded by Director DeLaTorre, the Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the special meeting of the Board of Directors held on December 13, 2016.
- DEMANDS** Upon motion by Director Chan, and seconded by Director DeLaTorre, the Board voted unanimously to approve the payment of checks numbered 18549 through 18606 from the General Account in the aggregate amount of \$550,059.57, and checks numbered 11012 through 11043 from the Revolving Account in the aggregate amount of \$40,680.88 for the December, 2016 invoices.
- PUBLIC COMMENT** Director Chavez of Upper San Gabriel Valley Municipal Water District was in attendance. He reported on Upper District's recent election: that Director Trevino was appointed because no challenger filed to run against him; that he, Director Chavez, was named President of the Board; Al Contreras defeated former Director Touhey, and Director Contreras was named Vice-President of the Board; and Director Trevino is the new representative to Metropolitan Water District.
- DISTRICT COUNSEL** District counsel reported regarding consolidation of elections, the details of the governing statute, and input from the Los Angeles County election official who oversees consolidations.
- ACTION** None.
- INFORMATION** The December 2016 Banking and Investment Report was received and filed.  
The December, 2016 Water Well Report was received and filed.

COMMENTS**

The General Manager presented a report summarizing time value investments and offered his opinion that it appeared the District could get a better return with such an instrument than it presently receives from LAIF (.68%).

The General Manager provided an update on the process of hiring a security firm for District's facilities, and the various quotes received. Director Taylor inquired regarding the effectiveness of placing surveillance cameras, wondering whether such a measure would actually prevent anyone from causing harm. After discussion, the Board directed the General Manager to give more thought to the matter and to consider alternatives such as installing alarms on hatches and doors at District facilities.

COMMENTS**

Director Cammarano reported on a recent newspaper article concerning the general public's mistaken perception that storm runoff simply washes out to the ocean. Director Cammarano expressed her surprise to learn that the capture rate for rainwater is 90%, and she felt this fact would be illuminating for District ratepayers. To this end, she suggested that this fact should be included in a newsletter. It was agreed that the District would publish a newsletter this year, and this item would be included.

**RESOLUTION NO. 01-17-493**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF  
SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT  
AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 01-93-288 (ADMINISTRATIVE  
CODE) AS IT RELATES TO THE ELECTION OF DIRECTORS**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SAN GABRIEL  
COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, as follows:**

**1. Scope and Purpose.**

This resolution amends the San Gabriel County Water District Administrative Code to change the date of the election of Directors pursuant to Elections Code section 10404 to encourage maximum voter turnout and minimize costs.

**2. Amendment.**

Article 2, Section 2.01 of Resolution No. 1-93-288 (Administrative Code) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**"2.01 Election and Appointment**

(a) Directors shall be elected and appointed in accordance with the Act, except the date of election shall be the same date as the statewide general election. Specifically, elections shall be held on the first Tuesday following the first Monday in November of each even-numbered year. The dates of any nominations, notices, canvass of voters, certification of election, and all other procedural requirements shall comply with those of the statewide general election.

(b) Directors whose terms of office would have, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, expired in 2017 following the election, shall now instead continue in office no later than December, 2018. Directors whose terms of office would have, prior to the adoption of this Resolution, expired in 2019 following the election, shall now instead continue in office not later than December, 2020.

(c) Each candidate for District office may prepare a candidate's statement of qualifications on an appropriate form provided by the Registrar. Such statements shall not exceed 200 words in length. The Registrar shall prepare and distribute the statement of qualifications in accordance with the Elections Code. The Registrar shall collect, at the time each candidate avails himself/herself of these services, a sum not greater than the actual prorated costs of printing, handling, and transmitting the candidate's statement, if any, incurred by the District as the result of providing this service."

**3. Other.**

Except as provided herein, Resolution No. 1-93-288 (Administrative Code) is hereby reaffirmed and readopted.
