The General Manager reported that Well#15 is back on line with a rebuilt GENERAL MANAGER motor and working properly; that mid-year budget review will be presented **COMMENTS** to the Board at the next meeting which will start at 3:00 pm to afford more

time for the item; that Jim Prior and Casey Feilen met with Upper San Gabriel Valley MWD to start discussions on scheduling a "state of the water" meeting which would include the District and other water providers in the area; that District received a copy of a letter sent to the San Gabriel Mayor and City Council by Daniel Bryant (copy was distributed to the Directors); staff is having discussions to consider potential connection to Metropolitan Water District to provide back-up water supply in the event of need with initial estimated costs of \$3M(connection and transmission pipeline) and an estimated time period of 2 years with this item coming to the Board for consideration in the future once the discussions result in more concrete information; that District received a call from a customer requesting that her smart meter be replaced with a regular meter due to health concerns.
