INFORMATION The April 2020 Banking and Investment Report was received and filed.

Director Cammarano reported that she has recently seen residents watering their lawns, and commented that it seemed like good news for the purposes of District

revenue.

Director Chan inquired as to the year-to-year comparison on expenditures, and the General Manager advised that it was a variety of factors, including the lack of any

capital improvement projects, due, in part, to the coronavirus pandemic.

Director Taylor commented on the year-to-year comparison on water sales.

GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS

The General Manager reported that all staff was to return the next week, abandoning the "A/B" stagger, but that their return to physical presence at the office would also be on a staggered basis, with certain staff starting and ending their workdays at different times, in order to minimize contact.

The General Manager reported that a customer has requested a new meter for a third house on her lot. Staff investigation revealed that she actually has three houses on two lots, and staff will advise her about the next steps she must take. This will include what she has been told previously: that she must hire a plumber to split the water lines.

DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Director Cammarano inquired as to the process for acquiring and filing election papers, and whether the COVID shutdown has affected candidates' ability to physically access County facilities for this purpose. Staff advised that they would look into the matter.

The Baldwin Park Key Well is located in the central portion of the San Gabriel Valley within the City of Baldwin Park and is used by the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster to monitor changes in the groundwater supply for the Basin. Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
