San Gabriel County Water District AWIA compliance

The America's Water Infrastructure Act (AWIA) became law in October of 2018, it requires a utility of our size to conduct a Risk and Resilience assessment of our water system. We also need to update our current Emergency Response Plan and we have until June 30, 2021. Staff would like to get this completed sooner than later and we are getting a group deal going through PWAG. This will get us in compliance before the required date and then we will be compliant for the next five years.

### Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation that Claris Strategy build San Gabriel County Water Districts AWIA compliance plan.



### Water Levels as of April 30, 2020

Listed below are the water levels in the Baldwin Park Key Well and Wells owned and operated by San Gabriel County Water District.

The Baldwin Park Key Well is located in the central portion of the San Gabriel Valley within the City of Baldwin Park and is used by the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster to monitor changes in the groundwater supply for the Basin. Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
