#### MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT HELD ON OCTOBER 12, 2021

#### CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District was called to order on Tuesday, October 12, 2021, at 8366 Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:02 p.m., available to the public via teleconference.

#### **ROLL CALL**

The Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District convened a regular meeting on October 12, 2021. Present at the District office were General Manager Jim Prior, Carmen Corona, Casey Feilen, Directors Taylor, Cammarano, DeLaTorre and Chan and District Counsel Koczanowicz.

#### **AGENDA**

Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre and seconded by Director Chan, the Board voted to adopt the agenda as presented; passed 4 - 0.

#### PUBLIC COMMENT

Board Interviewed Domingo Sauceda and George Carney, two candidates for the vacant Director seat. Both were present in person. Mr. Sauceda is a retired code enforcement manager for housing program in City of Los Angeles. Mr. Carney is a retired math teacher and currently works as an energy/utilities delivery manager for the school district on part time basis. He also serves on the San Gabriel Civil Service Commission. Each provided brief responses to questions regarding their experience with management, budgeting and contact with City Councilmembers. They were advised by Director Taylor that an appointment would be made by the Board at the next Board meeting.

#### **MINUTES**

Upon motion by Director Chan and seconded by Director DeLaTorre, the Board voted to approve the minutes for the meeting of the Board of Directors held on September 28, 2021. Motion passed 4-0.

#### **DEMANDS**

Director DeLaTorre motioned to authorize an electronic funds transfer with check numbers 12549-12576 from the general account to the revolving account in the amount of \$106,509.97 and a payment from General Account in the amount of \$301,257.05 which includes a voided check 21589 and 21593-21640. The motion was seconded by Director Cammarano. Director Chen asked about several check entries, including a voided check and payments for AWIA, water audit preparation, roof replacement and painting of Water Well 14 as well as EFT payments for various items. Director Cammarano asked about water tax payments to the City. Staff answered the questions to the Board's satisfaction. Motion passed on a 4-0 vote.

#### DISTRICT COUNSEL REPORT

District Counsel reported that there has been no response to the Estrada claim rejection letter.

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

Board considered the award of a contract for installation of Mainline Replacement Phase II to the lowest bidder Fraijo Brothers. For the replacement of 400 feet of 6-inch steel mainline on Roses Rd. Between Del Mar Ave and Gerona Ave in the amount of \$116,000. Motion to approve by Director DeLaTorre, seconded by Director Cammarano passed on 4-0 vote.

## MISC INFORMATION

Water Well report was provided to the Board. Director Taylor questioned the inconsistent depth readings in Well 16. Staff confirmed that the readings were erratic and could be caused by faulty sensor. New transducer was just installed.

#### GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS

The General Manager circulated photos taken by Casey Feilen showing San Gabriel & Morris reservoir. Drought discussion and possibility of Stage 2 conservation was discussed.

General Manager reported that an informational meeting with MWD and Upper District to discuss drought and MWD connections will take place on October 21, 2021. He also reported that Well 15 is back on line and working; that Civil Tech renewed the contract with the District at the same rate; that "safety" gift-cards will be ordered; that Holiday Lunch is still on schedule for December 12<sup>th</sup> at the Hilton and that only 3 of the District's employees have not received their Covid-19 vaccines.
