CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District was called to order on Tuesday, September 14, 2021, at 8366 Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m., available to the public via teleconference.

ROLL CALL

The Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District convened a regular meeting on September 14, 2021. Present at the District office were General Manager Jim Prior, Carmen Corona, Casey Feilen, Directors Taylor, Cammarano, DeLaTorre and Chan. District Counsel O'Neill participated by telephone.

AGENDA

Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre and seconded by Director Chan, the Board voted to adopt the agenda as presented; passed 4 - 0.

PUBLIC COMMENT Tom Love and Nicole Delgado from Upper District presented on the statewide water supply situation.

MINUTES

Upon motion by Director Chan and seconded by Director Cammarano, the Board voted to approve the minutes for a special meeting of the Board of Directors held on August 24, 2021. Motion passed 4-0.

DEMANDS
