CALL TO ORDER

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District was held on Tuesday, February 26, 2019, at 8366 Grand

Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

President Taylor; Directors Cammarano, Chan, Cici, and DeLaTorre; General Manager Prior; Assistant General Manager Feilen; and District Counsel Colin O'Neill were present.

AGENDA

Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre, and seconded by Director Cammarano, the Board voted unanimously to adopt the agenda for this regular meeting of the Board of Directors held on February 26, 2019.

PUBLIC COMMENT MINUTES None.

The January 2019 Banking and Investment Report was received and filed.

GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS The General Manager reported on a recent news release from Watermaster, adding that it had been posted on the website.

There was a discussion concerning the timing requirements of Form 700's.

The General Manager reported that he wished to increase District crews' workboot allowance to \$200.

The General Manager reported on a presentation he attended at the Water Association, and that a speaker, commenting on Governor Newsome's preference for one tunnel for the California Water Fix, stated that that would

only be viable if the single tunnel was significantly larger that than each of the twin tunnels' design.

Additionally, a State Representative will be circulating a letter of support for a water "trust," as opposed to a water "tax."

The General Manager reported that the implementation of the new Caselle software was proceeding well, and that staff was in their last week of training.

FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS

- Eliminating election days from District holiday list
- Increase in employee workboot allowance

DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Director Cici inquired whether separate meters were required for all new developments, and the General Manager replied that they were. The General Manager elaborated on future plans for smart meter infrastructure.

Director Cammarano asked whether MWD was offering a landscape rebate and the General Manager replied that it was, and it had to be conducted through Upper District.

Director Cammarano inquired whether pavers were more environmentally friendly than solid concrete, and the assistant General Manager said that he believed so, but also added that permeable concrete was another available option.

Upon motion by Director Cammarano, and seconded by Director DeLaTorre, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting.

The Baldwin Park Key Well is located in the central portion of the San Gabriel Valley within the City of Baldwin Park and is used by the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster to monitor changes in the groundwater supply for the Basin. Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
