Section 1. Purpose

This Resolution amends Resolution No. 6-96-329, Personnel Manual, as it relates to Employee footwear.

Section 2. Amendment

Section 6.06 of Resolution No. 6-96-329 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

### 6.06 Uniforms

The District shall provide uniforms for employees who are required to operate and maintain the District's water system. All employees required to maintain the District's water system are required to wear steel toed shoes in order to protect The employee's foot from injury. The District will provide reimbursement for Purchase of such shoes up to a maximum of \$200 per employee per year."
