ROLL CALL

The Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District convened a Special meeting on December 14, 2021. Present at the District office were General Manager Jim Prior, Carmen Corona, Casey Feilen, Directors Cammarano, DeLaTorre, Chan, Sauceda and District Counsel Koczanowicz. Director Taylor was present by Zoom call.

AGENDA

Upon motion by Director Cammarano, Seconded by Director Sauceda the Board voted to adopt the agenda as presented; passed 5 - 0.
