MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT HELD ON JANUARY 25, 2022

CALL TO ORDER A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County

Water District was called to order on Tuesday, January 25, 2022 at 8366

Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

The Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District convened

a regular meeting on January 25, 2022. Present at the District office were General Manager Jim Prior, Carmen Corona, Casey Feilen, Directors Taylor, Cammarano, DeLaTorre, Chan, Sauceda. District Counsel Koczanowicz appeared telephonically due to Covid-19 protocol.

AGENDA Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre and seconded by Director Suaceda, the

Board adopted the agenda as presented on a 5-0 vote.

PUBLIC No public was present at the meeting COMMENT

MINUTES Upon motion by Director Chan and seconded by Director Sauceda, the

Board unanimously voted to approve the minutes for the meeting of the Board of Directors held on January 11, 2022, with one minor typo

correction from Director Chan.

DEMANDS Director DeLaTorre motioned to authorize payment of electronic funds

transfer from the general account to the revolving account in the amount of \$146,383.44. The motion was seconded by Director Cammarano. Some discussion took place about a rounding error. Motion passed on a 5-0 vote.

DISTRICT COUNSEL REPORT

District Counsel regretted not being able to attend in person and had no

significant matters to report.

ACTION ITEMS None

MISC INFORMATION

Board was advised that the District received ACWA JPIA President's

Special Recognition Award for achieving excellent results in keeping a loss

ratio of 20% or loss. General Manager and Directors project the staff for

ratio of 20% or less. General Manager and Directors praised the staff for

this achievement.

Board also received and filed the December 2021 Banking and Investment. Director Chan commented that the District continues to have safety lunch expenditures, which is a good indicator that work safety is important to staff.

GENERAL MANAGER REPORT

General Manager reported that Staff will be presenting the comparison between MWD connection costs and redrilling Well 8 at the next Board meeting; he also reported that the District will be purchasing a 24'X40' Modular Building to be used as an office, thus moving staff from the warehouse where conditions were crowded. This will also be before the Board for a decision at the next meeting. General Manager also reported that the new truck should be arriving on February 9th, 2022, as well as the District logo Jackets. Lastly General Manager met with a city of San Gabriel Arson Investigator, who was trying to establish the value of the water used in the fire-fighting activities for San Gabriel. The amount was estimated at 6 million gallons, costing \$35,000. These numbers were important to establish the level of crime committed for prosecution purposes. Some discussion was held among the Directors regarding the event and also questions were asked about active shooter scenario training. All questions were addressed by staff to Board's satisfaction.

DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Director Chan inquired about the health of the staff and asked if the Board had any interest in considering virtual meetings again. There was no interest. Director Cammarano asked about fire hydrant flushing activities and reminded everyone about the June 14, 2022. City of San Gabriel 250th Anniversary gala event; she also informed the Board of passing of a long time Kiwanis member and a community contributor Bob Bodkin. Director Sauceda thanked staff for the tour of the District facilities and stated that it was very informative and eye-opening, as far as how much property is under District's control and responsibility.

Upon motion by Director Taylor, seconded by Director Cammarano the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 4:28 p.m.

This year the District budgeted \$135,000.00 to purchase a modular office for the field staff. This amount is to cover the building, concrete pad, electrical and furnish the inside. Staff received three prices for a modular building. The building consists of a private office, HVAC, electrical outlets, skirting and a wheel chair ramp. The three prices are as follows:

Commercial Sales Specialist \$49,563.99

iModular \$48,261.94

Global Modular \$70,000.00

Subject: MWD connection and Well 8 exploratory well

This year the District budgeted \$500,000.00 to investigate an MWD connection to enhance our emergency water supply. The cost to having MWD find a connection point and give us initial plans on the location is \$92,000.00 which we are partnering with Sunnyslope Water Company which brings our cost to \$46,000.00. Staff would also like to drill an exploratory well at our Well 8 location to see if water quality has improved enough to possibly drill a well at that location. The estimated cost for an exploratory well would be \$200,000.00. Staff feels it would be in the best interest of the District to explore both scenarios for future water supplies.

Recommendation:

It is staff's recommendation to move forward with MWD connection and well 8 exploratory drilling.



Listed below are the water levels in the Baldwin Park Key Well and Wells owned and operated by San Gabriel County Water District.

The Baldwin Park Key Well is located in the central portion of the San Gabriel Valley within the City of Baldwin Park and is used by the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster to monitor changes in the groundwater supply for the Basin. Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
