Water District was called to order on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 at 8366 Grand

Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL Present at the District office were General Manager Jim Prior, Casey Feilen,

Carmen Corona, Directors Taylor, Cammarano, Chan, DeLaTorre, Sauceda

and District Counsel Koczanowicz.

AGENDA Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre and seconded by Director Cammarano,

the Board adopted the agenda as presented on a 5-0 vote.

PUBLIC COMMENT No members of the public were present, no public comment received.

The Baldwin Park Key Well is located in the central portion of the San Gabriel Valley within the City of Baldwin Park and is used by the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster to monitor changes in the groundwater supply for the Basin. Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
