### MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT HELD ON JULY 12, 2022

**CALL TO ORDER** 

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County Water District was held on Tuesday, July 12, 2022, at 8366 Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.

**ROLL CALL** 

President Taylor; Directors Cammarano, Chan, and Vice President DeLaTorre; General Manager Prior; Assistant General Manager Feilen; Finance and Administration Manager Corona; and Deputy District Counsel Christine Carson were present. Director Sauceda was absent.

**AGENDA** 

Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre, and seconded by Director Cammarano, the Board voted unanimously (4-0) to adopt the agenda for this regular meeting of the Board of Directors held on July 12, 2022.

PUBLIC COMMENT MINUTES There was no public present until later in the meeting.

Upon motion by Director Chan, and seconded by Director DeLaTorre, the Board voted unanimously (4-0) to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of the Board of Directors held on June 28, 2022 with one amendment that where it says that Director Chan asked about a pipe, it was

actually Director Taylor.

**DEMANDS** 

Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre, and seconded by Director Chan, the Board voted unanimously (4-0) to approve checks in the aggregate amount of \$704,282.17 which includes check numbers 22044-22087 from the General Account as set forth in the check register in the agenda packet, and checks totaling \$25,705.29 in electronic funds, including the payment of check numbers 12856 through 12878 (noting voided checks 12862-12863) from the revolving account.

DISTRICT COUNSEL Christine Carson introduced herself as filling in for District Counsel, and did not have a report.

ACTION

**INFORMATION** 

The Water Well Report and report of water levels as of June 30, 2022 included in the agenda packet was received and filed. The District rehabbed Well 14 and is pumping more without as much of a draw-down. The District is obtaining an estimate on another well rehab and information from a hydrologist on a good location for a well.

GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS The General Manager reported that the new garden service started, and blinds for the field office came in.

The General Manager also reported on conservation efforts and the drought

as follows:

- If we do not have rain by November in Southern California we could reach an all-time low, but the District saved another 4% over the water year.
- Metropolitan Water District of Southern California's allotment of water is a concern.
- The Carson project is 5-6 years out.
- Director Camarrano said the photos of Diamond Valley Reservoir are interesting and show the water line.

## DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Director Cammarano commented on receiving the District newsletter, which is very good. Director Cammarano also discussed the National Night Out in the Mission District at which the District will have a booth with information.

Director Taylor requested a newsletter, which Ms. Corona said she would provide.

Director Chan expressed concern for how the staff is doing. He also indicated that a ratepayer mentioned a leak but told him it was taken care of and she was happy with that. The rate payer indicated she had emailed the District and initially did not get a response, but the leak was resolved to the customer's satisfaction.

The directors welcomed a member of the public who had arrived at the meeting.

Upon motion by President Taylor, and seconded by Director Cammarano, the Board voted unanimously (4-0) to adjourn the meeting at 4:30 p.m.
