CALL TO ORDER A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County

Water District was called to order on Tuesday, March 14, 2023, at 8366

Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL Present at the District office were General Manager Jim Prior, Carmen

Corona, Casey Feilen, Directors Taylor, Cammarano, De La Torre, Sauceda

and Mamdapurkar and District Counsel Koczanowicz.

AGENDA Upon motion by Director De La Torre and seconded by Director Taylor, the

Board voted unanimously to adopt the agenda as presented.

Jackie Taylor was present and greeted by the Board but did not provide any **PUBLIC**

COMMENT comment.

MINUTES Upon motion by Director Suaceda and seconded by Director Taylor, the

Board voted to approve the minutes for the meeting of the Board of

Directors held on February 28, 2023. Motion passed 5-0.

DEMANDS Director De La Torre motioned to authorize payments from the General

Account in the amount of \$370,991.55 (chk#22439-22489) and an

electronic funds transfer from the general account to the revolving account in the amount of \$28,432.42 (chk#13143-13170). The motion was seconded by Director Taylor. Staff answered questions to the satisfaction of the Board relating among others to check numbers 22459 (developer contractor), 22458 (Doty Bros. for main and service leaks) 22488(supplies and stock parts) 22479 (S&J valve replacement) and 22457 (Day Wireless). Board

also discussed digital meter reading and valve replacement frequency. Motion passed on a 5-0 vote.

DISTRICT District Counsel briefed the Board on a Coastal Act case Spencer v. City of COUNSEL

Palos Verdes Estates, where Court found city's failure to control threatening and abusive behavior of a local surfer club toward any "outsiders" trying to surf at the local beach to be a violation of Coastal Act as it limited access to

the public beach.

MISC Receive and File: Board received the Water Well report. Director Taylor **INFORMATION**

noted that storage amounts have increased. Director Cammarano

commented that the Baldwin Park Key Well is up from 181.8 to 185.6, a

good sign of increasing supply.

GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS	The General Manager reported that the rainfall was at 23.5 inches, well above the 15 inch annual average. He also reported that water usage is down (no need for irrigation) and that Directors De La Torre and Sauceda will be at a conference on May 9 th and will be calling in for the board meeting.
