MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SAN GABRIEL COUNTY WATER DISTRICT HELD ON NOVEMBER 28, 2023

CALL TO ORDER A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County

Water District was called to order on Tuesday, November 28, 2023, at 8366

Grand Avenue, Rosemead, California at the hour of 4:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL Present at the meeting were General Manager Jim Prior, Carmen Corona,

Casey Feilen, Directors Cammarano, Taylor, DeLaTorre, Sauceda and Mamdapurkar. District Counsel Koczanowicz attended via Zoom.

AGENDA Upon motion by Director Taylor, seconded by Director Sauceda, the Board

voted unanimously to adopt the agenda as presented.

PUBLIC None COMMENT

MINUTES Upon motion by Director DeLaTorre and seconded by Director Taylor, the

Board voted to approve the minutes for the November 14th, 2023 regular and

two special meetings of the Board of Directors. Motion passed 5-0.

LIST OF DEMANDS Director DeLaTorre motioned to authorize an electronic funds transfer from

the general account to the revolving account in the amount of \$167,535.26.

The motion was seconded by Director Sauceda and passed unanimously.

DISTRICT
District Counsel did not provide a case summary due to the sporadic Zoom
connection and a need for visual aids for the presentation. The presentation
will be provided at the December 12, 2023 meeting. He did report that the

ACWA conference appeared to be well attended.

ACTION ITEMS: 2024 BUDGET AND POSITION AND COMPENSATION CHART General Manager provided a brief summary of the 2024 Budget, explaining that the document reflected the discussion at the special meeting of November 14th. Director Taylor inquired about the Administrative leave item and was informed that the additional admin leave did not have an effect on the budget and could be discussed by the Board as a separate item at a future meeting. Director Taylor moved to adopt Resolution No 11-23-523, approving the 2024 budget. Director Sauceda seconded and motion passed

unanimously.

Director Taylor then moved to adopt Resolution 11-23-524, authorizing the new Position and Compensation chart. Director DeLaTorre seconded and motion passed on a 5-0 vote.

MISC INFORMATION

Receive and File: October 2023 Banking and Investment and Revenue and Expenditure Reports were provided to the Board. Director Cammarano commented on a very favorable interest rate in the LAIF account; Director Taylor had a question on YTD expenditures, which was answered to his satisfaction.

GENERAL MANAGER COMMENTS

The General Manager confirmed that the second meeting in December will be cancelled and that the December 12th meeting will start at 4:00 pm. He also reported on the upcoming rehabilitation on the reservoir, which will be funded from the capitol account. A discussion ensued regarding the details of the rehab work and Director Mamdapurkar requested a future agenda item dealing with estimates of water loss due to the condition of the reservoir. The item will be agendized for a future meeting.

DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Director Cammarano informed the Board that the city of San Gabriel will be hosting a tree lighting ceremony on December 5th, 2024 which will include "taste of San Gabriel" event. Local restaurants will be featuring items from their menus for public tasting. She also stated that on December 7th and 8th for the 60th year in the row, baskets for the needy will be put together to be distributed before the holidays.

Director Taylor enquired about PFAs and was informed that the District did not have that issue in the water supply.

Board adjourned to closed session for General Manager Evaluation

Board returned into open session. No reportable actions were taken by the Board in closed session. Upon motion by Director Sauceda, seconded by Director Taylor, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 4:42 p.m.

Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
