CALL TO ORDER A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the San Gabriel County

Water District was called to order on Tuesday, April 23, 2024, at 8366

ROLL CALL Present at the meeting were General Manager Jim Prior, Finance and

absent.

AGENDA Upon motion by Director Taylor and seconded by Director Sauceda, the

Board voted unanimously to adopt the agenda as presented.

MINUTES Upon motion by Director Sauceda, seconded by Director Taylor, the Board

voted to approve the minutes for the meeting of the Board of Directors held

on April 9, 2024. Motion passed 3-0.

DEMANDS Director Cammarano motioned to authorize an electronic funds transfer

> from the general account to the revolving account in the amount of \$85,972.76 The motion was seconded by Director Taylor. No questions

were asked by the Board. Motion passed on a 3-0 vote.

DISTRICT District Counsel briefed the Board on a trial court decision in a case brought by a number of charter cities against the State of California, challenging the COUNSEL REPORT

constitutionality of SB 9. That legislation removed majority of

discretionary decision-making process from the cities, when it came to approval and development standards for Accessory Dwelling Units. Trial Court granted a petition for a writ of mandate invalidating the state law passed under SB9 based on the fact that the State failed to make the necessary findings related to public health and welfare when adopting SB9.

This trial court decision will likely be appealed.

General Manager noted that the water sales were up and that District is expecting a large check this year from the developer of the "nursery" project. Director Taylor inquired about the freeway crossing project and the number of connections it will serve.

The General Manager reported that the operating safe yield may be increased next month going from 4100 to 4400 ac.ft.; he informed the Board that one of the rentals across the street has a viable candidate and will likely rent next month. Mr. Casey reported that the Longden Reservoir work was progressing well with the roof and center beams being patched and repaired.

The Baldwin Park Key Well is located in the central portion of the San Gabriel Valley within the City of Baldwin Park and is used by the Main San Gabriel Basin Watermaster to monitor changes in the groundwater supply for the Basin. Each vertical foot is equivalent to about 8,000 acre-feet of groundwater in the Main Basin. The Key Well elevation is measured at sea level.
